The main objectives of universities are to provide high quality and comprehensive education, cultivate research culture and disseminate knowledge. For some research, the benefits may not be so obvious. As Albert Einstein once remarked, "If we knew what it was we were doing, it would not be called research, would it?"

Nevertheless, it is the research which is the foundation for knowledge that makes possible so much of innovation and application that provides wider benefit. There is a large element of serendipity in research and we need to acknowledge that, for every successful connection between research and application, there are many projects that will not succeed in the same way. But such research, nevertheless, adds to the stock of global knowledge and provides the source of new ideas, methods, techniques and innovation across a whole range of disciplinary and multi- disciplinary areas.

South eastern University of Sri Lanka is keen to develop research culture among academic, administrative staff and students by offering moral and financial support. Annually an international symposium is conducted by the University. An international or national research conference is conducted by each faculty of the university.

In this trend, the Faculty of Islamic Studies and Arabic Language conducts international symposium every year to enhance research ability to the internal academic staff and to offer

opportunity to the other academics, experts and researchers to share their findings, new ideas and innovations. In addition, the Faculty conducts annual research colloquium for final year special Degree students to present their research proposals and get comments and ideas from the experts.
